PLATFORM OVERVIEW

GOLFiGO is the management platform behind national golf – live-scored competitions, WHS handicapping, tee times, memberships, licensing and online payments in one system. **In production since 2021**, it is today the official and exclusive platform of the **Hungarian Golf Federation** and the **Hungarian Footgolf Federation** – every national championship, club competition, handicap and license in the country – and the **European Senior Golf Association (ESGA)** has chosen it as the platform for its upcoming championships and other international events. More than **25 separate organizers** – federations, clubs and independent tournament organizers – run their events on it, and the platform contains more than **2,500 competitions** with startlists, results, statistics and handicap history reaching back almost 10 years.

Three surfaces, one source of truth.

Every piece of data – a score, an entry, a handicap, a booking, a payment – lives once and appears everywhere it should: in the administrator's back office, on the public website, and on the player's phone.

All three surfaces are **one responsive web application**: no app to download, nothing to install or update, working on every phone, tablet and browser. A golfer scans a QR code on the first tee and is scoring seconds later – on a device they already own.

The platform is **modular**: federations, clubs, organizers, referees and commercial partners each get their own account with role-based permissions, and every module – competitions, tee sheet, licensing, online payment – can be licensed independently. Start with what you need; switch on the rest when you're ready.

What sets it apart.

Scoring without paper

Markers score from a QR code – no app install, no login. Player and marker each keep an independent digital card, sign on the phone, and the moment both have signed the result locks and becomes official. The leaderboard updates within about half a minute.

Handicaps that run themselves

A full WHS engine: qualifying scores post automatically at round closure, playing conditions are calculated daily, and every golfer can forecast – before playing – exactly how a planned round would move their index.

Golfers organize their own golf

With PLAY, any golfer sets up their own game in a minute – multiple flights, own tee times, QR invites – and runs a small competition among friends with a live leaderboard the clubhouse can follow.

One checkout for everything

Tee times, competition entries, licenses and memberships are all paid online through one payment flow, invoiced automatically, and settled to your clubs with accounting statements – from checkout to bookkeeping without manual work.

Statistics players come back for

Putts, greens in regulation, fairway accuracy, pace of play – plus every hole a golfer has ever played, averaged against the same hole played by the field. Favourite and nemesis holes, public course statistics and a hole-in-one wall of fame keep the whole membership on the platform between competitions.

Your brand, your connections

Each federation runs the platform under its own domain, colors and feature set – and where the law or your ecosystem requires it, GOLFiGO connects to government registries and external systems, as it already does in Hungary daily.

Live scoring & digital scorecards

The flagship: paperless scoring that holds up to championship rules – from the QR code on the first tee to a signed, locked, official result on the leaderboard.

Scoring from a QR code – no app, no login

Every flight gets a short, readable code (three letters, three digits), printed as a QR on the scorecard and shown in the startlist email. Scanning it opens the flight's digital scorecard immediately: hole-by-hole score pad with par-relative labels, automatic advance to the next player or hole, stroke allowances shown per hole, and running totals – plus inline entry for longest drive and nearest-the-pin with a live top-3.

And for golfers who *are* signed in, no code is needed at all: the system recognizes them and their own flight, scorecard and signature link are already waiting – along with their entries, bookings and handicap record. Anonymous when it should be effortless, personal the moment you sign in.

Online scorecard signature – the digital scorecard

With one competition setting, GOLFiGO reproduces the player-card / marker-card convention digitally. Markers are assigned automatically in each flight; player and marker each keep an **independent card** and enter both scores. If the two contradict each other on a hole, the second entry is rejected with the counterpart's value shown – discrepancies get resolved on the course, not in the committee room. When the card is complete, both parties sign on the phone; a signature can be revoked while the other is pending, and on the **second signature the scores lock and become official automatically**, with the exact signed scores stored as an audit snapshot. The committee sees signed/unsigned status per player and per marker at a glance.

The 66th Hungarian Amateur Open live leaderboard: 54 holes across two courses, color-coded hole-by-hole scores, three-round totals and a fair "%" ranking while the field is still on the course.

A leaderboard for the clubhouse and the world

Scores appear on the public leaderboard within about 30 seconds of entry. Spectators filter by result category and round, switch between stroke, stroke-HCP, gross and net views, pin their favourite players, and open any row into a full scorecard. An auto-scroll mode turns any TV into a clubhouse leaderboard, and players on the course can reach the duty referee with one tap.

Competition management

From a Thursday club evening to the national open: one engine covers the full lifecycle – announcement, entries, startlists, live play, results and handicap posting.

- Stroke play and Stableford, gross and net, with configurable maximum-score variants
- Game formats: single, matchplay, best-ball, fourball, foursome, greensome, scramble
- Multi-round events with cuts; rounds on different courses; 9 or 18 holes
- Single-tee, two-tee and shotgun starts
- Unlimited leaderboards per event – by age, gender, nationality, licence, entry type or any custom criterion
- Tie rules: play-off, count-back, shared places; special awards and prize draws
- Per-round local rules, pin positions; course data versioned so history stays correct
- Referee assignment, referee reports, live pace-of-play monitoring per flight

Startlists that build themselves

The flight assistant calculates how many flights fit your interval, then builds the field under your constraints (automatically if you like) – flight size, tees per flight, genders per flight, maximum handicap spread. Waves and shotgun (with A/B tees) included. Publish with one click and every golfer is notified automatically with their personal scorecard link.

Results, published properly

Close a round and every leaderboard is computed at once – each category with its own scoring and tie rules. Results go to the public site, notification emails go to the field, points feed season standings, and qualifying scores post straight into the handicap engine.

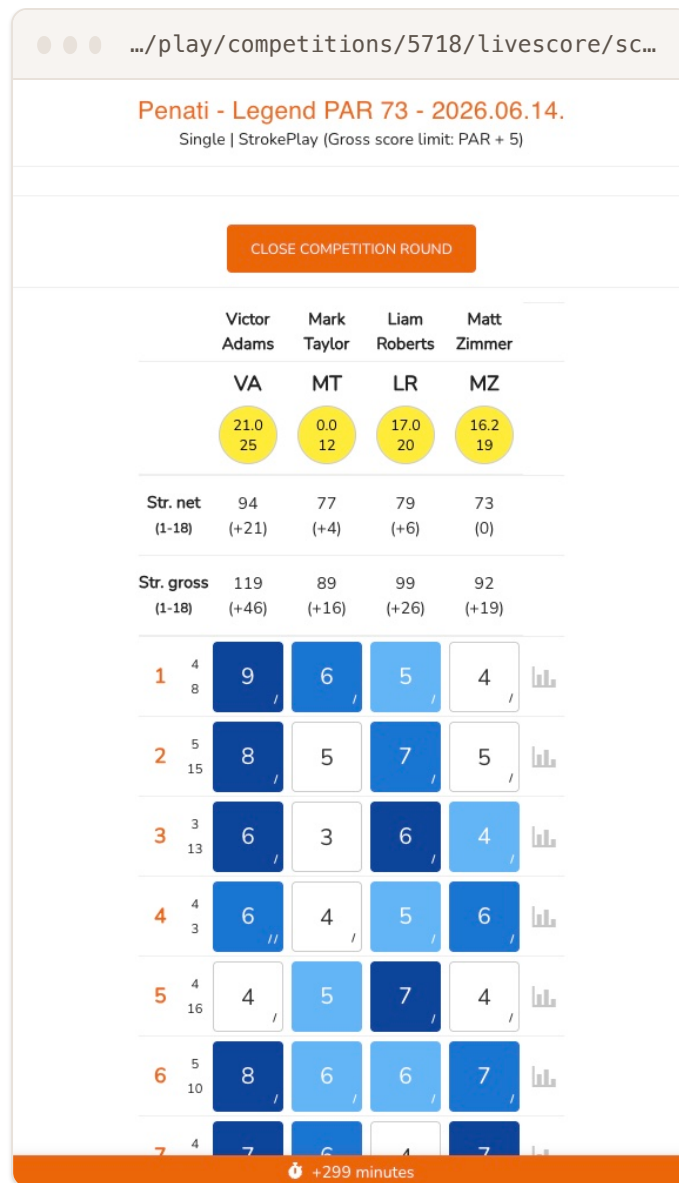

One event, many leaderboards: Open Men, Open Women and national gross categories, each with playing handicaps and updated indexes per player.

PLAY – golfers organize their own games

Official competitions are half the story. With PLAY, any golfer creates their own game – or a small competition among friends – and the platform treats it with the same care as a championship.

- Create a game in a minute: club, course, stroke play or Stableford
- **Multiple flights per game**, each with its own tee time and start hole – a self-organized mini-tournament, even shotgun-style
- Playing partners join by scanning the flight's QR code – no invitation emails, no setup
- Add players from favourites (auto-learned from who you actually play with), search the golfer database, or add guests by name
- Live hole-by-hole scoring with the same scorecard used at national championships
- A share link + QR makes the leaderboard public – family and friends follow live, no account needed
- Shot statistics captured while playing: putts, greens, fairways, bunkers, penalties
- Score a hole-in-one and the app offers one tap to call the clubhouse – and order the champagne



PLAY on a phone: the flight's live scorecard – PHCP badges, running gross and net totals, color-coded hole scores and the pace bar.

Statistics, records & the wall of fame

Shot-level statistics from every scored round – and, built strictly from official results, a second layer that measures every hole a golfer has played against the same hole played by everyone else. It spans competitions, courses and years, and most of it is public: statistics become content for the whole golfing community, not just a feature for the player who logs in.

- Shot-level stats per hole: putts, greens in regulation, fairway accuracy with miss direction, greenside bunker shots and recoveries, penalties
- Personal hole statistics: the golfer's average against par on every hole played – per hole, per course and by par 3/4/5 – always shown next to the field's average on that same hole
- Favourite and nemesis hole, favourite and nemesis course – awarded automatically once the golfer has enough rounds on record
- Score distribution on every hole – albatross, eagle, birdie, par, bogey, double bogey and worse – as percentage shares, in the same colour code the live scoring uses
- Every figure recomputed per window: last 5, 10 or 20 rounds, or last year, last 3 years and all time
- Personal pace-of-play statistics: your speed vs. the pace plan, vs. the field you played with, vs. all golfers – overall and per course
- Public course statistics, no login required: how far over par the field plays each hole, the easiest and hardest hole and course, and the lowest score ever recorded on each hole – filterable by gender, age category and tee
- A field pace benchmark per course: the fastest and slowest course over the chosen period, measured against each round's own pace plan and projected onto 18 holes, so 9-, 18- and 27-hole rounds compare directly
- A wall of fame of every official hole-in-one: player, course, hole and tee, filterable by year and by course, each ace linking through to the player's profile
- Per-competition course statistics: hole averages, birdie/par/bogey distributions, filterable by gender, handicap band and round
- Live pace monitoring for referees during events: a flight-by-hole delay grid with printable schedules
- Numbers a committee can defend: only official scores from closed, handicap-qualifying rounds count, always the player's own ball – shared-ball formats are excluded – each statistic can be switched off per course, and every table is rebuilt nightly, so a corrected result corrects the statistics with it

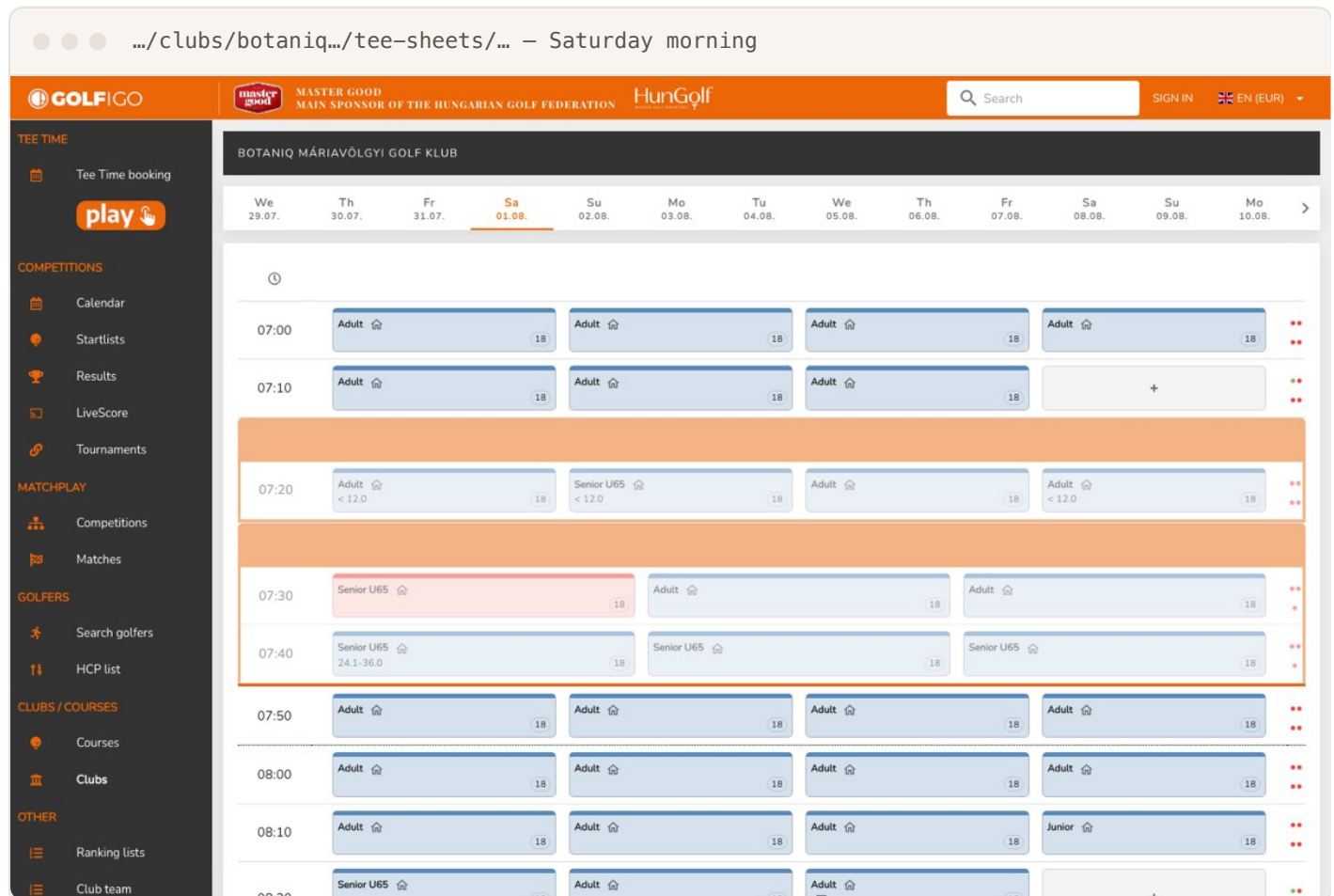

Tee-time booking

A real-time booking grid for golfers and guests – availability at a glance, member pricing and any other discounts applied automatically, and payment done before anyone reaches the pro shop.



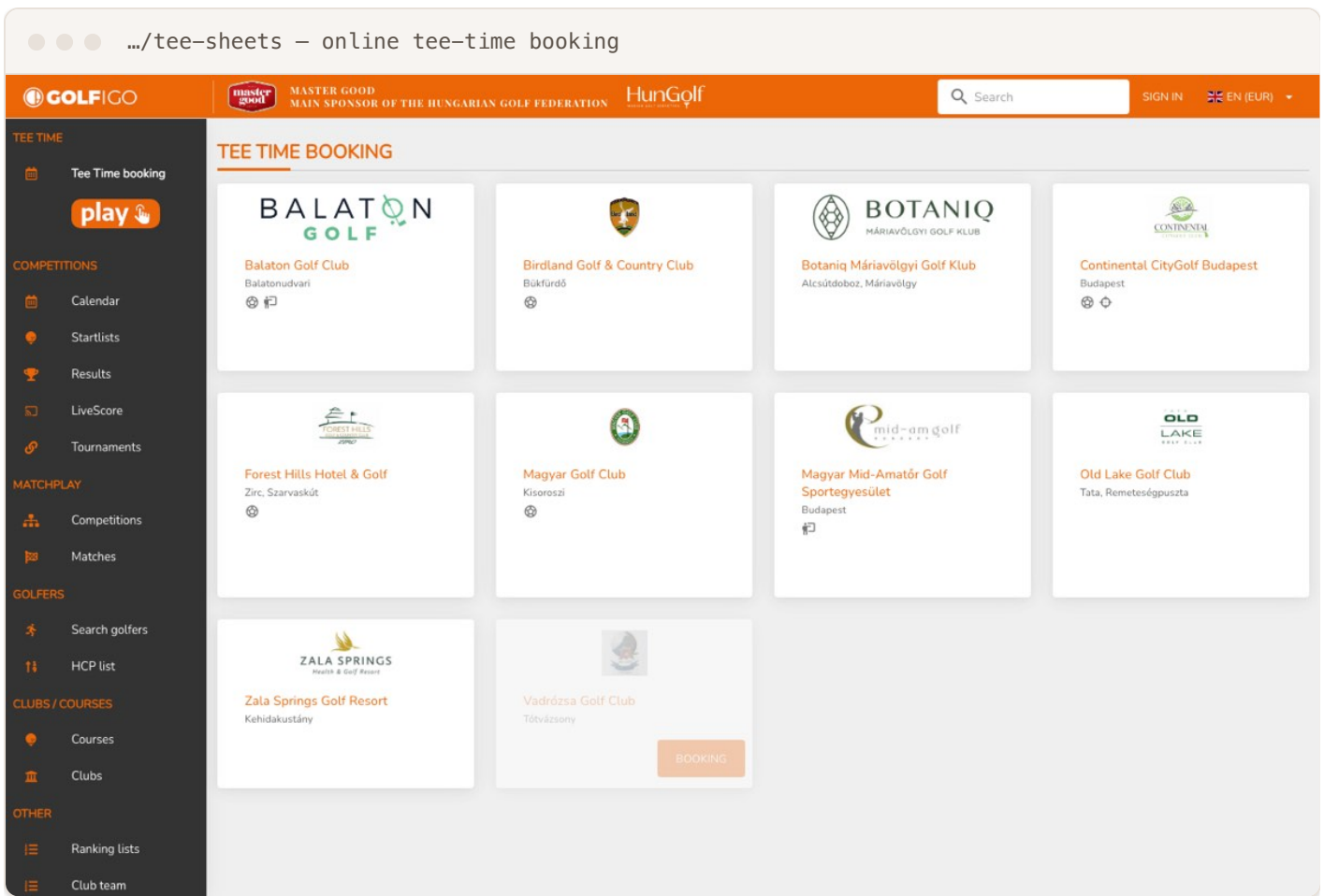
The live booking grid on a busy Saturday: a scrollable date strip, four slots per tee time with age category, member and handicap badges, event bands blocking reserved windows, and free slots one tap away.

Booking in one dialog

A golfer picks a free slot and books for the whole group: playing partners from favourites or the golfer database, guests by name, carts and trolleys as add-ons – with each player's price computed from their own membership package and visibly attributed to it. Pay online or on site; teammates who don't pay online automatically receive their own payment email.

- Confirmation email with booking code, QR check-in code and a calendar attachment
- Self-service by booking code – move the time, add products, pay or cancel, no login needed
- Member benefits built in: longer booking windows and package pricing per member type

- Cancellation policies with transparent, time-based fees shown before confirming
- Events and member-only windows block public slots automatically
- Embeddable booking widget for the club's own website



One booking front door for the whole federation – each club with its own courses, products and prices.

Entries & event e-commerce

Online entry that enforces your rules and collects your money. Golfers enter, pay and withdraw themselves; the committee watches the field fill up.

- Entry windows with member early access, entry caps and withdrawal deadlines
- Acceptance by entry order or by handicap
- Handicap limits – simple, detailed or per gender; age and nationality restrictions
- Entry fees and add-on services (buggy, dinner, caddie) sold at entry time
- Prices targeted by age group, gender, membership package or individual golfer; discount codes
- Bulk entry import from Excel with row-level error reporting; full list exports
- No-show cases with sanctions – sanctioned golfers are rejected from new entries automatically
- Rich-text broadcast email to any subset of the field

Handicap management (WHS)

A World Handicap System authority in software: every qualifying score posts automatically, every adjustment is audited – and golfers can see their handicap's future, not just its past.

- Automatic score differentials; qualifying competition scores post at round closure
- Daily playing-conditions calculation (PCC), soft and hard caps, low index tracking
- Golfer record sheet with an index chart over the last 50 values and counting scores highlighted
- General play, away scores, penalties, corrections and reviews with approval workflow
- Printable handicap history and self-service HCP certificate PDF
- Proficiency ("green card") certificates with QR-coded digital cards

HCP Forecast – the "what-if" every golfer wants

Before a competition, a golfer picks the event (or any course and tee, or a fully custom setup), enters a hypothetical score, and sees the projected new index, low index and playing handicap – including a table of "shoot this, get that". Alongside it, a public handicap calculator shows the playing handicap on every tee of every course in the country from a single input.
